

## Food Waste Collection is Here!

Woodland residents can now place food scraps and food-soiled paper in their green waste cart for composting!



Food Scraps: Egg Shells, Meat & Bones, Vegetables, Etc.  
Food-Soiled Paper: Pizza Boxes, Coffee Grounds, Paper Towels, Etc.

Separating food scraps and food-soiled paper for composting is easy and helps Woodland and California meet goals to reduce the amount of waste disposed in the landfill.

By now you should have received a service brochure that highlights the new materials to place in your green waste cart. If you haven't received the new brochure, please contact customer service at 530-662-8748.

Remember, all food scraps from bones to meal preparation trimmings should be placed in your green waste cart (brown lid). Food-soiled paper such as paper towels, greasy pizza boxes and coffee filters with used grounds should also be placed in the green waste cart.

If you bag your food scraps, please use only BPI certified compostable bags. Please check your local grocery store, big box retailer or online shopping site for BPI certified compostable bags.

Please separate your food scraps and food-soiled paper to help make Woodland and California cleaner and greener!

Woodland's annual free bulky drop off day will be held on Saturday, April 14 at the Yolo County Fairgrounds from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. (Please use the Gibson Road entrance to the fairgrounds.)

**Items Accepted:** Sofas, Furniture, Mattresses, Large Appliances, Wood, Tires, and Electronic Waste (televisions, printers, computers, microwaves and cell phones).

**Not Accepted:** Household Hazardous Waste (automotive fluids, lawn and garden

chemicals, fluorescent tubes and bulbs, paints).

**Reuse Section:** Reusable items that are brought for disposal will be placed in a "reuse" area for the public to take free of charge.

**Paper Shredding:** Need to shred some old documents? There will be an industrial paper shredder on hand to shred documents free of charge.
